## *Holy Thursday*

**Come prepared for the Washing of Feet** (women, no nylons). You are invited to share in the Washing of Feet. If you would rather not, remember Peter didn't like the idea either. There will be six stations set up in the aisles of the church. Simply sit in one of the chairs remove your socks and shoes; after your foot is washed, you are invited to wash the foot of the next person.

**Bring a can of food or a non-perishable food item with you to church for the poor** (a can of tuna, a box of pasta, a jar of peanut butter, etc.). According to the church's custom on this evening, these items will be brought to the altar along with the bread and wine, helping us to consider the love of Christ for us all on the night before he died.

**Hold a candle and stand together in gratitude for the gift of the Eucharist** as the procession makes its way down the main aisle out the main doors of the church through the driveway to the chapel. Everyone will be invited to join in the procession.

**Visit the chapel for Solemn Adoration after Mass until Night Prayer which will be celebrated at 11PM. On this, the night celebrating the Institution of the Eucharist at the Last Supper, Private Adoration will continue all through the night. A sign up list is located in the hallway near the chapel entrance.**

## *Good Friday*

**Help Carry the Cross.** Remember Simon of Cyrene. On Good Friday at the 2PM Service and the 7PM Stations we are in need of several parishioners willing to help hold and carry the large wooden cross, just like Simon did on the original Good Friday. If you are willing, please sign the signup sheet on the table near the church entrance.

**Hold a candle near the cross as it is venerated.** Volunteers are needed during the 2PM Service to stand near the cross while it is venerated holding a candle to proclaim the fact that we find joy and hope in the cross of Jesus. Signup list is on the table near the church entrance.

**Come prepared to Renew your Baptismal Promises as you come to celebrate the Easter Eucharist.**
